
- Make sure you have your MPRR or training and education records available.

- Once you find relevant training, hit "enter" and it will add to "My______
 Experience".
- You can add Rank, and Language profile






- After your information has been entered, hit "search" ICON.

- After you hit search, review your results.
 - Nota: Not all qualifications have credit recognition! It is up to the Education institution to provide us with which qualifications they recognize.


